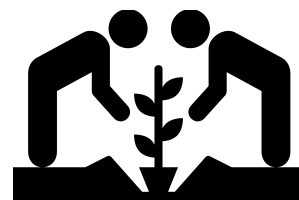

What is Run Jump Throw Wheel?

A physical activity program that serves as a strong foundation for all sports, providing physical literacy and led by instructors (NCCP certified) specifically trained to teach the fundamentals of running, jumping, throwing and wheeling (for children in wheelchairs).

Running including: Starting technique, Posture & body, Arm & Leg Action, Hurdling, Pacing and Relays.

Jumping including: Approach, Take-off, Flight and Landing.

Throwing including: Preparation, Building momentum, Delivery, Follow through and Recovery.

Wheeling - participants in wheelchairs will learn throwing techniques from a seated position, learning proper wheeling technique and control in place of running and jumping.

All activities are designed to teach fundamental movement skills using developmentally appropriate progressions to introduce and develop skills, with skill consolidation done through games and skill challenges.

Lebanese Bean Salad

2 cans kidney beans

1 can chickpeas

2 celery stalks, chopped finely

1/2 red onion, chopped finely

1 medium cucumber, chopped

1 cup parsley, chopped finely

2 TBSP mint, chopped finely

1/4 c olive oil

1/4 c fresh lemon juice

3 cloves crushed garlic cloves

1 tsp red pepper flakes & 1/2 tsp. Salt

Combine beans, chickpeas, celery, onion, cucumber, parsley, and mint. Whisk together olive oil, lemon juice, garlic, red pepper flakes, and salt. Combine with beans and let marinate for at least 2 hours.

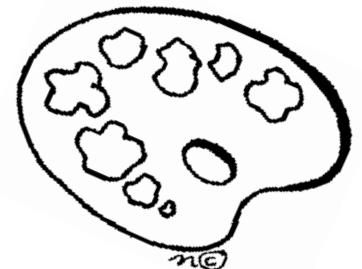
