Brevoort Park School staff and students want to wish you all a healthy and happy new year! We are excited for all of the learning opportunities that we have coming to us in 2018 including a focus on citizenship education.

Several years ago, the Saskatchewan Human Rights Commission (SHRC) partnered with the Ministry of Education to create resources designed to empower
students as citizens. Brevoort Park School has been chosen as one of 8
elementary schools in our school division to pilot these Concentus
resources. Social studies inquiry units will encourage children to discover and
reflect upon the 3 R's of Canadian Citizenship: Rights, Responsibilities and
Respect and the 5 Essential Citizenship Competencies: Englightened,
Empowered, Empathetic, Ethical and Engaged. We are thrilled and excited at
the possibilities this learning focus may bring to the school community.

This month, we are looking forward to our first STEM Family night, which will give families an opportunity to engage in science, technology, engineering and math activities. Basketball and Indoor Track seasons are underway, and teams are practicing regularly and beginning game schedules with the help of staff volunteers. Registration for Kindergarten for the 2018-19 school year is open and we are busy helping parents ready their young children for their first steps into schooling. ## Easy Slow Cooker Meal! Lentil Sweet Potato Curry

1 diced onion, 2 cups red or brown lentils, 2 cups diced sweet potato,

1 large sliced carrot, 14-ounce can coconut milk, 15-ounce can diced tomatoes, 1 tablespoon curry powder, and 2 teaspoons salt.

Add 4 cups of water to slow cooker and cook for 6-8 hours on low. Serve with basmati rice
