

















Sidewalk Snow Clearing

During the winter months, snow and ice on sidewalks can seriously impair the ability of people to get around safely - especially the elderly and those with mobility restrictions. For that reason, the City of Saskatoon has a bylaw in place requiring owners or occupants of property to clear sidewalks of snow and ice to prevent injury or inconvenience to pedestrians.

The Sidewalk Clearing Bylaw, 2005 (No. 8463) requires that residential sidewalks must be clear of snow and ice within 24 hours of a snowfall. The areas to which this Bylaw applies are outlined on maps in Schedule A

(starting on page 8) of the Sidewalk Clearing Bylaw, 2005 (No. 8463).



The Refugee Sponsorship Committee from Ecole St. Matthew has raised close to the \$30,000.00 needed to support and relocate their refugee family to Saskatoon.

Although the monetary requirement is a significant component to bringing a sponsored refugee family to Canada, the immigration and international legal processes take time. Currently their anticipated arrival is between 12-18 months. However, the momentum continues for reaching the remaining funds which sits at approximately \$1000.00. A social justice student committee within the school community of Ecole St. Matthew has been formed to help engage additional initiatives to assist obtaining these funds. École St. Matthew School Update


