Supervised Skating at the Brevoort Park Rink

To encourage family skating, we offer three, 2-hour public skate times each week.

Public Skate Times

Fridays: 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Saturdays and Saturdays: 1:00-3:00 p.m.

During these times, we need volunteers to ensure that these times remain stick- and puck-free.

Remember that volunteering doesn't mean that you are out on the ice the whole time (unless you want to be!). Email rink_supervision@brevoortpark.ca to sign up for a shift.

Brevoort Park Rink Rules

- Use the facility at your own risk.
- Prevent injury by using protective equipment.
- Do not bring breakable containers on the ice.
- Do not leave shovels or scrapers on the ice.
- Share the ice surface and nets. They are intended for everyone's enjoyment.

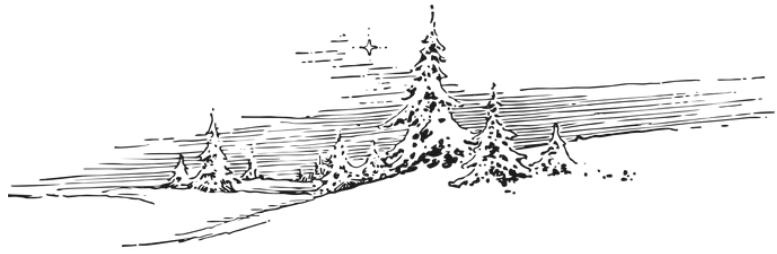
