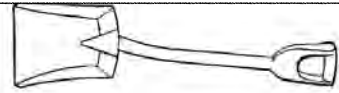
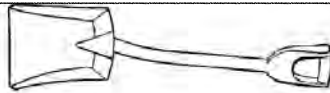
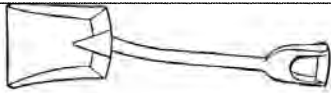

Sidewalk Snow Clearing

During the winter months, snow and ice on sidewalks can seriously impair the ability of people to get around safely - especially the elderly and those with mobility restrictions. For that reason, the City of Saskatoon has a bylaw in place requiring owners or occupants of property to clear sidewalks of snow and ice to prevent injury or inconvenience to pedestrians.

The Sidewalk Clearing Bylaw, 2005 (No. 8463) requires that residential sidewalks must be clear of snow and ice within 24 hours of a snowfall. The areas to which this Bylaw applies are outlined on maps in Schedule A

(starting on page 8) of the Sidewalk Clearing Bylaw, 2005 (No. 8463).

The Sidewalk Clearing Bylaw, 2005 (No. 8463) requires that residential sidewalks must be clear of snow and ice within 24 hours of a snowfall. The areas to which this Bylaw applies are outlined on maps in Schedule A

If your neighbour is elderly, has health concerns or mobility restrictions, lend a hand by clearing their sidewalks. And when clearing sidewalks, please exercise caution and care, especially during extremely cold weather.

If receive help from your neighbour, nominate them as a "Snow Angel." Send an email to snow.angel@saskatoon.ca or write your story to Public Works, City of Saskatoon, 222 - 3rd Avenue North, Saskatoon SK S7K 0J5, along with the name and address of your Snow Angel.

The City will send an anonymous thank you to the Snow Angel, and enter them into monthly prize draws made this winter.

École St. Matthew School Update

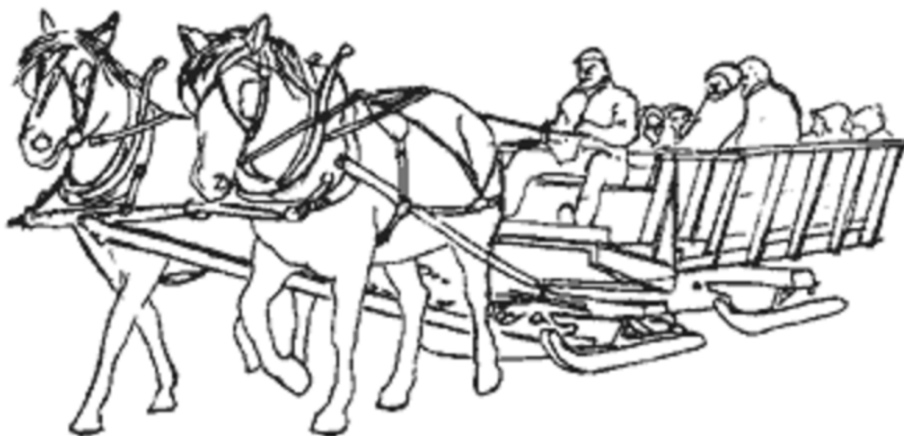
