For the Love of Your Lawn and Garden, Compost!

Interested in being a wizard of breaking down organic waste?

The City and the Saskatchewan Waste Reduction Council (SWRC) have developed a home composting program to turn your organic waste into a rich soil conditioner that will divert waste, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Below is some information to help break down the basics of composting:

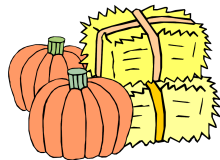
- The key to making a home compost pile that decomposes fast, doesn't smell, and doesn't attract pests is to follow the 5-step recipe: green material, brown material, water, soil, and air.
- Compost Coaches are a valuable asset. Attend their workshops, set up a FREE home visit or group demonstration, and even learn how to become one, all by visiting: compost@swrc.ca.
- Read the "Compost Bin How-To Guide" or view the "Composting in 60 Seconds" video series, whenever and wherever you desire.
- Reduce your water bills and waste using your very own rain barrel or compost bin with a \$20 rebate provided by the City.
