City Update with Councillor Block

Hello Brevoort Park -

I hope you are enjoying spring and looking forward to outdoor activities in your beautiful neighbourhood and beyond. Here are a few highlights from City Hall:



- 1) Housing Accelerator Fund The federal program designed to improve the quantity and affordability of housing in our city includes recommendations for big changes in our zoning rules. Lam particularly concerned about the plan to add 4 storey buildings, as of right, within 800 metres of a Bus Rapid Transit Terminal, as this could impact your neighbourhood. To learn more: www.saskatoon.ca/Engage
- 2) Flood Mitigation: Brevoort Park South will begin construction this year to reduce flood risk in an area with a history of significant flooding and expected future flooding. The plan is to create a fully underground storage containment system, and with community, design the above ground park space to improve the green space.
- 3) Home Energy Loan-Program (HELP). The program provides low interest loans to single-family homeowners for energy efficiency upgrades and renewable energy installations that are repayable through property tax. It was oversubscribed in the last round, and now round two is underway. www.saskatoon.ca/HELP
- 4) Homelessness The City and the Province continue to seek space to provide housing for the unhoused. With more people needing shelter and a lack of supply, Saskatoon Fire and Police are working to address immediate needs and risks.

A few other notes:

Construction season is underway and we can expect delays on College Drive throughout the spring and summer, as the water main and road are rehabilitated to get ready for Bus Rapid Transit, expected to debut in 2027.

By the time you read this, the much-anticipated public market at River Landing will be open, with the traditional outdoor farmers market. "Gather" will be open 6 days a week and offer an array of food and activity. This new rendition of the River Landing market promises to combine the best of the beloved tradition with more options and opportunities to connect with local food, vendors and talent. I hope to see you there!
