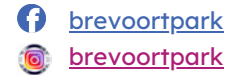

## Big Mama's Homemade Hamburger Helper

## Directions

1. Brown the Beef: In a large pan, brown the ground beef over medium heat. Season with salt and pepper.
2. Add Ingredients: Stir in pasta, broth, milk, pasta sauce, spinach, oregano, basil, and parsley.
3. Simmer: Bring to a low boil or simmer. Cover and cook for about 20 minutes, stirring occasionally, until pasta is tender and most of the liquid is absorbed. Add extra broth if needed.
4. Add Cheese: Once pasta is cooked, turn off the heat and stir in the shredded cheddar. Let sit for 5 minutes to allow the cheese to melt.
5. Mix & Serve: Stir well and enjoy this cozy, satisfying meal!

## Ingredients

- 0.5–1 lb ground beef, chicken or turkey
- 2.5 cups small pasta (uncooked)
- 1.5 cups broth (plus extra if needed)
- 1.5 cups milk
- 1 cup tomato pasta sauce of your liking
- 2 cubes frozen spinach or 1 cup fresh
- 0.5 tbsp oregano
- 0.5 tbsp basil
- 0.5 tbsp parsley
- 1.5 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- Salt & pepper to taste
